

KEEPING OF LARGE ANIMALS IN THE SHIRE OF CAPEL Info Note 12

INTERPRETATION

In this division, unless the context otherwise requires:

“Cow” includes an ox, calf or bull;

“Horse” includes an ass, mule, donkey, pony or miniature pony;

“Large animal” includes an alpaca, cow horse, sheep goat, deer camel, lama, emu. ostrich, kangaroos or the like but does not include a pig,

“Stable” means a building for the keep, care and feeding of a horse; and

“Stall” means a single compartment for one horse in a stable.

CONDITIONS FOR KEEPING OF AN ANIMAL

- (a) Pigs may not be kept within the Shire of Capel.
- (b) An owner or occupier within the Residential zones, as defined under the Town Planning Scheme of the Council, shall not keep a horse, cow or large animal on these premises.
- (c) An owner or occupier within all Special Rural zones, as defined under the Town Planning Scheme of the Council, shall not keep a horse, cow or large animal on these premises without the approval of Council.
- (d) An owner or occupier of premises who has an approved animal shall ensure –
 - The premises has an area of not less than 0.2 hectares for the exclusive use of the approved animal: and
 - The approved animal does not approach within 30 metres of a dwelling.
