Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

The Shire of Capel Youth Services is proud to present the “Visions For Our Future” Youth Art Competition. The aim of this competition is to encourage young people to express their hopes, identity, and connection to community, culture, and nature through art.

2. Eligibility

- Entrants must be Year 7 to Year 12 (age equivalent home-schooled youth accepted) at the time of submission.
- All entrants must reside or go to a School within the Shire of Capel (Capel, Dalyellup, Boyanup, Peppermint Grove Beach, Gelorup, Capel River or Stratham).
- Only one entry per person.
- A Parent/Guardian Consent Form must be completed and submitted with the artwork.

3. Entry Guidelines

- ❖ Theme: “If you could shape the future for young people in the Shire of Capel – what would it look like?”
- ❖ Creative interpretations may explore: Community, Culture, Nature, Dreams, Identity, or Growth.
- ❖ Art Forms accepted:
 - Painting: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolour, Gouache
 - Illustration: Ink, Pencil, Charcoal
 - Collage: Mixed media including images, textures, and materials.

4. Submission Requirements

Each entry must include:

- Name and age of the artist
- Title of the artwork
- A maximum 100-word statement explaining the meaning of the artwork
- A completed Parent/Guardian Consent Form
- All submissions must be original works and not previously published or entered other competitions.

- Judging will be based on creativity, interpretation of the theme, and artistic merit.
- All decisions made by the judging panel are final.
