What is a Pump Track:

A **pump track** is a looped circuit of banked corners and smooth rollers – plus any other features riders might want to throw in. Unlike a conventional off-roading circuit, they're designed so that riders are completely powered by their own momentum, with no pedalling or pushing required.

Benefits of a Pump Track:

Pump tracks provide a free to use sports facility and the opportunity to improve cycling/wheeled skills in a safe environment. They also provide the opportunity for physical and social activity for all ages, leading to better mental and physical health and community cohesion¹. Other benefits of pump tracks include:

- All ages and skill levels can learn in the same location.
- Pump tracks create a fun and positive atmosphere.
- Many people can use a pump track without disturbing the neighbours.
- Pump tracks are popular and will draw a crowd to your venue.
- Pump tracks get people active and exercising

Project Brief:

The Dalyellup Pump Track project is an element of what forms part of a larger project that is known as Dalyellup Stage 19 POS M.

Dalyellup Stage 19 POS M see’s multiple elements come together in what will be a vibrant and family friendly Public Open Space (POS), with supporting infrastructure such as:

- A new Multi-purpose Community Facility (Currently in final design and funding phase)
- A Nature Play Park (Completed as part of POS M)
- The recently completed Dalyellup Skate Park
- A vibrant new landscape zone with footpaths and landscape furnishings connecting all these elements including the neighbouring residential and commercial zones surrounding the entire precinct.

The Pump Track is being constructed by Satterley Property Group as part of their Developer contribution, with minor co-funding from the Shire of Capel.
