

# Emergency Services Bush fire mitigation notice variation

#### Introduction

In accordance with the provisions of Section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, the Shire of Capel adopts an annual Bush Fire Mitigation Notice specifying the minimum standards of fire prevention measures to be undertaken by property owners.

For varying reasons, it may not be possible for the property owner to meet Council's requirements.

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is intended to provide the authority to issue variations to the annual Bush Fire Mitigation Notice.

# **Policy statement**

That the Chief Executive Officer, Director Infrastructure and Development or Emergency Services Coordinator, in consultation with the relevant Bush Fire Control Officer are authorised to approve or refuse an application for variation to the Bush Fire Mitigation Notice. Any variations approved, will be provided in writing to the property owner.

## **Application**

Responsibility for the application of this policy is the Emergency Services Coordinator.
