

Emergency Services Standard Operating and Administrative Procedures

Introduction

The Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES) as the Hazard Management Agency for fire maintains Standard Operating and Administrative Procedures that outline the procedures to be followed in fire operations.

These Standard Operating and Administrative Procedures are commonly used by Local Government as the procedures for the Bush Fire Service supporting interagency operability.

Access to the Standard Operating and Administrative Procedures are available to all volunteers on the DFES volunteer hub.

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to endorse the use of DFES Standard Operating and Administrative Procedures by the Bush Fire Brigades.

Policy statement

That the Shire of Capel adopts the Standard Operating and Administrative Procedures determined by DFES as the Standard Operating and Administrative Procedures for Bush Fire Brigades in the Shire of Capel.

Application

The application of the Standard Operating and Administrative Procedures Policy relates to Bush Fire Brigade volunteers, fireground operations and appliances.
